NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Commission had announced the schedule for Special Summary Revision of electoral roll with reference to 01.01.2018 as the qualifying date for the State of West Bengal *vide* its letter dated 13th July, 2017, fixing inter-alia, the 22nd August, 2017 as the date of draft publication and the period 22nd August, 2017 to 13th September, 2017 as the period for filing claims & objections; and

Whereas, the draft rolls for 291 Assembly Constituencies of West Bengal State (Except 22-Kailmpong, 23-Darjeeling and 24 Kurseong Assembly Constituencies) were published on 22nd August, 2017; and

Whereas the Commission has received proposal from the District Election Officer of **Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur & Malda** to extend the period for filing claims & objections in view of the flood like situations faced in the said districts and having considered the view of CEO, West Bengal conveyed vide his letter dated 5th September, 2017, the Commission has decided to give more time to the public to file claims & objections, and has further decided to extend the period for filing claims & objections till 20th September, 2017 and for additional special campaign dates 16th & 17th September, 2017 (Saturday & Sunday);

Now, therefore, the Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Rule 12 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, extends, for following 27 Assembly Constituencies of aforesaid three districts as per schedule of this order in West Bengal, the period for filing claims & objections upto 20th September, 2017, for the ongoing Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls with reference to 01.01.2018.
