Special Continuous Updation Programme, 2016

After Final Publication of Electoral Rolls, 2016, the period for Continuous Updation programme begins. Under Continuous Updation programme, citizens who want to enrol their names in the electoral rolls and are otherwise eligible have still an opportunity to get enrolled. The highlights of the Special campaign being undertaken this year are as follows:

1. The Special Continuous Updation Programme will continue from **05.01.2016 to 17.01.2016**. During this period, the Booth level Officer/Designated Officer will be available in their respective Polling Stations from 11.00 am to 04.00 pm.
2. During this period (05.01.2016 to 17.01.2016), a person has an opportunity to file *relevant forms* at the Polling Station before the Booth Level Officer (BLO)/Designated Officer.
3. Special Camps for enrolment will be organized on **10.01.2016 and 17.01.2016 (Sundays)** to ensure maximum participation of citizens.
4. **Booth Level Agents** (BLA) of Political Parties will hold a meeting with the BLOs in the respective Polling Stations on **10.01.2016 and 17.01.2016 (Sundays)** at **12.00 Noon** to discuss and identify eligible persons who are yet to be enrolled/ corrections etc.
5. **Special Enrolment Drive in Educational Institution-** All educational institutions (higher secondary schools and colleges) to open special window in their institution 06.01.2016 to 22.01.2016 to survey and inform all eligible but unenrolled students to file application for registration.
6. However, after 17.01.2016, the Continuous Updation activities will continue as per prescribed procedure of the Commission, when a person can file his claim in the respective Electoral Registration Officer's Office only.
