In order to assess preparedness in connection with the ensuing General Assembly Election, 2021, West Bengal, the full bench of the Election Commission of India led by Sri Sunil Arora, Chief Election Commissioner, Sri Sushil Chandra and Sri Rajeev Kumar, Election Commissioners of India is going to visit the State on and from 20<sup>TH</sup> January, 2021 and will hold review meetings with stakeholders related to the conduct of elections.

Commission will be meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2021 with representatives of political parties followed with meeting with Officials of the Central & State Regulatory agencies. In the post lunch session, a review meeting will be held with Divisional Commissioners, District Election Commissioners, Zonal IGs Range IGs, SPs and CPs on issues related to conduct of the forthcoming General Elections to West Bengal Legislative Assembly, 2021.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2021, the Commission will be meeting with the Chief Secretary, Home Secretary, Director General (Police) and other senior State Officials. The Commission will also be meeting with representatives of the Press at around 12:30 pm at the Ball Room of the Oberoi Grand Hotel, Kolkata.
