



General Elections to the Lok Sabha 2014

As per sec. 171B & 171C of the Indian Penal Code, use of bribe in cash or kind, influence or intimidation or preventing a person from freely exercising his/her electoral right is a criminal offence punishable with imprisonment up to one year or/and fine. **Flying squads** have been formed to initiate legal action against such offenders. You are requested to report any such incident on **toll-free no.1950** of the specially set up 24 x 7 Complaint Monitoring Cell of your district as displayed on our website.

In order to vote, it is not enough to have EPIC alone. You must have your name enrolled in the Electoral Roll in order to cast your vote in the elections.

The Electoral Roll will be displayed and read out at your Polling Station from 11 am to 4 pm. on 9th March (Sunday). If your name is not included in the Electoral Roll, you are requested to submit an application in Form No.6 to the B.L.O on the same day.
