WHEREAS the power of requisitioning of premises, for election purposes, in connection with 16th general election to the Lok Sabha is vested to the concerned State Government under section 160 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

WHEREAS the polls for the Lok Sabha from West Bengal will be taken in five phases, i.e. on 17th April '2014, 24th April '2014, 30th April '2014, 7th May '2014 and 12th May '2014, further bye-elections to the West Bengal Legislative Assembly in 6 Assembly Constituencies, viz; 10-Kumargram (ST), 16-Maynaguri (SC), 86-Santipur, 91-Chakdaha, 256-Katulpur (SC) and 274-Galsi (SC) will also take place during the period.

WHEREAS the payment of compensation is to be made thereof under Section 161 of the said Act.

WHEREAS the State Government may confer any of the powers/duties imposed on that Government to such specified Officer or class of Officers under section 166 of the said Act.

Therefore, the Government of West Bengal in the Land & Land Reforms Department hereby delegates powers of requisitioning of premises (a) for a parliamentary constituency or a part thereof, or an assembly constituency in a district other than Kolkata, to the District Magistrate of the said district, and (b) for a parliamentary constituency or a part thereof in Kolkata, to the Returning Officer of the said parliamentary constituency where elections are scheduled to be held during the aforesaid period as mentioned under Section 160 of the said Act and also the power of determination of rate of compensation and payment of compensation to be made under Section 161 of the said Act and the power to release the premises from requisition as per provision of Section 165 of the said Act.

The District Magistrate and / or the Returning Officer concerned shall be liable to discharge the duties conferred on them.
