NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the Governor thinks fit so to do in the interest of Public Service;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Shops & Establishments Act, 1963 (West Bengal Act XIII of 1963), the Governor is pleased hereby to exempt, where the said Act applies in the State, all classes of petrol and diesel pumps (filling station) situated within the areas of the Constituencies as per the **schedule enclosed** on the occasion of holding Bye elections to 1 – Coochbehar (SC) Parliamentary & 30 – Tamluk Parliamentary and 263 – Monteswar Assembly Constituency.

The filling stations are granted exemptions from the operations of provision of Sub-Section (2) of Section 6 of the said Act, subject to the condition that any work done beyond eight and a half hours a day or forty eight hours a week shall be regarded as over time work for payment of over time wages under section 13 of the said Act.
