NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Election Commission had announced the schedule for Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls in the State of West Bengal with reference to 01.01.2018 as the qualifying date vide its letter No. 23/LET/ECI/FUNC/ERD-ER2017 (Vol.II) dated 23rd August, 2017; and

Whereas, the period for filing claims and objections was fixed from 22nd August, 2017 to 30th November, 2017; and

Whereas, the draft rolls were published on 22nd August, 2017 as scheduled; and

Whereas, the Election Commission has reviewed the progress of ongoing Special Drive being conducted during the period for filing claims and objections in the State; and

Whereas, the Election Commission has, on such review and also on request received from CEO, decided that the period for filing claims and objections in the State shall be further extended up to 15th December, 2017, so that period of Special Drive during the said period for filing claims and objections, also be extended to enable the Booth Level Officers to complete ongoing house to house verification in their respective polling station areas;

Now, therefore, the Election Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Rule 12 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, hereby extends the period for filing claims and objections in the State upto and including 15th December, 2017 for the current Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls with reference to 01.01.2018, as the qualifying date.
