Continuous Updation Programme, 2023


After Final Publication of Electoral Rolls, the period for Continuous Updation programme with reference to 01.01.2023 and subsequent qualifying dates i.e. 01.04.23, 01.07.23 and 01.10.23 begins. Under Continuous Updation programme, one may erroll one's name in the electoral rols, if otherwise eligible. The forms w.r.f the three subsequent qualifying dates shall be processed by the EROs under continuous updation during the relevant quarter. The Chief Bectoral Officer, West Bengal appeals to the electors of the State to verify their electoral status in the electoral rols. An elector may check the details of assembly contituency, polling station, his part and serial number in the electoral rol by any of the following means:

- ✓ Type WBO/ECOEPIC NO and send to 51969
- Access <u>www.ceowestbenaci.nc.in</u> and search your name in electoral rols with Voter Card number
- Download Voter Helpline App from Google Ray Store and know electoral details.

Cilizens may file form 6 for enrolment and form 8 for modification of their electoral details or shifting of names.

MAP OF WEST BENGAL


